

LEE/OGLE REGIONAL ADVISORY BOARD

In 1993 Public Act 88-89 made several changes in the method intermediate educational services were delivered to Illinois schools. The legislation declared that effective August 1, 1995, Educational Service Centers would be eliminated and services formerly provided by them would be transferred to 45 Regional Offices of Education. For each Regional Office of Education, the law stated that an Advisory Board would be established to oversee the planning and delivery of programs and services.

Based on the number and size of school districts in Lee and Ogle Counties, seven Advisory Board subregions were established in 1995.
