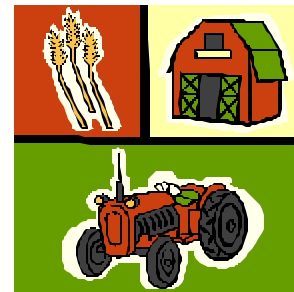




Summer Agricultural Institutes—2011
